Read Philippians 1:18b-26 together

1. What stands out to you most in Paul's words? Answers will vary.

 Paul says his deliverance will happen "through your prayers and the help of the Spirit of Jesus Christ." Why do you think prayer is so powerful in difficult seasons?
Ultimately, we communicate with our only hope, *with prayer*. Prayer has the power to totally shape how we process our circumstances.

Job and Habakkuk both are good reads on how prayer changes how we see things.
