ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! It's time to wake up! I wonder what we will see today that God made. Maybe a flower or a caterpillar or fluffy clouds? God made everything, so there is A LOT to see!"



Drive Time

While on the go, look for things in the sky. Do you see a bird, airplane, or clouds? Talk about how God made the great, big sky.



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, thank You for making the great big sky and the clouds up high. Help us remember how BIG You are every time we look up and see them."



Bath Time

Add plastic containers and scoops to bath time. As your child scoops and pours the water, talk about how God made the water in the oceans and rivers, lakes and streams, waterfalls and ponds. God made it all, because God made everything!



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
